INFORMATION FOR CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

An Educational Psychologist is interested in how children and young people learn and behave. They may have been asked to meet you by your school and your parent/carer.

If you meet an Educational Psychologist, they might complete some activities with you so they can find out things you are good at and the things you might need some help with. They might:

- **Talk with you about yourself and what is important to you**
- **See how you are getting on in the classroom or on the playground**
- **Play some games**
- **Complete some questionnaires**



The Educational Psychologist will work with the some of the adults in your life to understand how to support you best.

They will sometimes tell them what you say if this will help to make things better.
